Two-Day, In-Person Workshop Information

Date and Time

- This training event will take place from 8:30 am 3:30 pm Central Daylight Time (CDT) on Thursday, June 5 and Friday, June 6, 2025.
- Registration will begin at 8:00 am CDT. You will not be able to register prior to 8:00 am. The program will begin promptly at 8:30 am, so please give yourself plenty of time to park, find the building, register, and be seated by the 8:30 start time.
- We will end each day by 3:30 pm.

Event Location & Parking

- Both days of the in-person workshop will take place in Room 101 of the Ned McWherter Learning Resources Center (LRC). The LRC is location C4 on the attached map. You can also access an interactive campus map here: <u>Campus Map | Middle Tennessee State</u> <u>University</u>.
- Parking will be free <u>if you follow the directions for parking below</u> under "Parking for Participants" below.

- Select Create Guest Account (or go to your previously established account) Complete the process, and your electronic pass will be sent to you by email
- Download and print your parking pass and place it on your car dashboard before you arrive on campus. <u>CEM staff/offices will not print passes.</u>

- Follow the signs that say "LRC Event Parking" to get to the conference parking lots.
- With your parking permit, you can park in any parking space that is not handicapped, reserved, metered, or a tow zone. However, we recommend parking in the two lots that are closest to the LRC, which are highlighted on the map.
